




Proposed Financial Support for Regional Network Meetings


What is to be Funded?

▶ Expenses

- Travel expenses etc. towards the cost of one invited speaker per meeting from outside the region, who may otherwise be unaffordable. Not necessarily an APA Council member, but with known expertise or special knowledge on a particular topic.
 - Trainee prize for a presentation delivered at the meeting.

How Will this Help?

How will this help the networks?

- Make meetings more attractive by the addition of a known outside speaker.
 - Deliver particular CPD locally (regionally) on specific topics required.
- 

How Much?

Approximately what monies will be available?

- Up to £250 per meeting

Added Value?

How will the APA know we are getting "added value"?

- Specific questions within the meeting evaluation wrt
 - o the added value of the invited speaker
 - o the added value for trainees selected to give presentations
- Development of a list of names and topics as a resource for regional meeting organisers.

Conditions in Place

The meeting is regional in nature (i.e. not restricted to a single Trust or Institution), and preferably is organised by a regional network

- The meeting is intended to deliver refresher/update/core topics related predominantly to paediatric anaesthetic practice
- The meeting should be no profit or cost neutral
- The majority of speakers at regional meetings should be from that region
- APAGBI subsidised expenses will be limited to GB and Ireland speakers
- Delegate fees and organisational costs will not be subsidised
