We are very excited to invite you to collaborate in PAPAYA, Phase 2 of the paediatric unplanned day case admissions project. Thank you to all that helped with Phase 1.

Firstly you do not need to have been part of Phase 1 to be part of Phase 2. It is not too late to join the project now. This is going to be the largest trainee led, national paediatric audit. Get involved!

The timeline will be as follows:

<b>Launch</b>	<b>14<sup>th</sup> August</b>
<b>Registration deadline</b>	<b>8<sup>th</sup> September</b>
<b>Launch closes</b>	<b>6<sup>th</sup> October</b>
<b>Data collection 6 weeks</b>	<b>10<sup>th</sup> October – 21<sup>st</sup> November, including unplanned admissions on 21<sup>st</sup> November.</b>

We are capturing data on all day case procedures, under general anaesthetic, 0-16yrs for 6 weeks. There will be short proformas to complete for each of the unplanned admissions.

Please complete the attached registration form to sign your centre up to this project and send it to [PATRN.network@gmail.com](mailto:PATRN.network@gmail.com) Then set to work organising audit approval and setting up the project. There will be some logistics involved. Please do not leave these tasks until the night before, as you will not be able to participate.

By the end of launch (6<sup>th</sup> October) we **MUST** have a copy of your audit approval. Without a copy, we cannot include your results in the study.
