- Scientific Meetings. The Science Committee are involved in discussions with the Meetings Committee regarding the content and speakers for APAGBI Annual Meetings and regional meetings.
- Surveys. Applications for surveys of the APAGBI membership are reviewed, discussed with authors, and surveys of adequate quality and interest are distributed to the membership. Authors must provide results for publication on the APAGBI website.
- The Science Committee works with Council and other APAGBI committees to provide scientific input regarding position statements, requests for information, or joint projects.
