- The mean time to death in anaphylaxis to drugs is under 5 minutes.
- The window of opportunity to treat in perioperative anaphylaxis is shorter than in asthma.
- Most doctors have had **little or no training** in drug allergy and the diagnosis of patients with perioperative anaphylaxis.
