



Roddie McNicol Prize

In memory of Dr Roddie McNicol the APA is pleased to announce the launch of the inaugural Roddie McNicol prize for Regional Analgesia in children.

This award is open to trainees or consultants within 5 years of appointment*

This is advanced notice that there will be an annual award of £500 for a submission on regional analgesia in children.

The submission should be formed of a complete paper and an abstract based on either:

- An article published in a Peer Reviewed journal published during the last calendar year or
- An original review yet to be submitted to a Peer Reviewed journal.

The submission will be 4,000 words or less.

This prize will not necessarily be awarded every year but only if a submission of sufficient quality is received, as judged by a panel convened by the Scientific Committee of the APAGBI.

The prizewinner will be expected to make a 15-minute presentation on the topic to the APA Annual Scientific Meeting in Sheffield in June 2019.

The closing date for submission will be March 1st 2019 and should be sent to apagbiadministration@aagbi.org
